

Bauhaus Fellowships

The Klassik Stiftung Weimar awards Bauhaus Fellowships to promote innovative projects in the areas of art, media, design, literature, curatorial practice and cultural education.

Named after the world-famous school of art and design in Weimar, the Bauhaus Fellowships by the Klassik Stiftung Weimar support creative projects of outstanding merit. Each year several fellowships lasting two to four months are awarded to creative artists, students and graduates from around the world.

Our focus is on thematic flexibility and topics that raise public awareness. We want to give free reign to diversity and creativity. We are interested in projects which are directly or indirectly related to Weimar and contemporary issues. **Fellowship recipients should present their projects publicly**, for example, in the form of an exhibition, work presentation, event or intervention, and reach a broad audience via the media channels operated by the Klassik Stiftung Weimar.

Conditions

The fellowship includes a stipend of 1,500 euros per month. Due to construction work in 2026, the guest apartments in the historic Nietzsche Archive will unfortunately not be available. Depending on capacity, it may be possible to move into an apartment in the Pogwischhaus. However, this will not be possible for all Fellows. In this case, we ask you kindly to organize your own accommodation in Weimar, for which an additional accommodation fee of 500 euros per month will be paid. Please indicate your preferred period and an alternative period.

Required documents

- letter of motivation
- abstract of your project (10–15 lines)
- detailed project description outlining your prior work, tentative timetable and presentation concept (4–5 pages)
- CV in tabular form, list of publications or exemplary projects (if applicable)

Application deadline

Please submit your application documents by 31 July via our online application portal. All fellowship applications are reviewed and selected in September of each year. If your application is selected, your fellowship is to be commenced in the following year.
